1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of BNSS with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to respondent No.2 to conduct the fair and impartial investigation against respondent No.5.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 08.11.2024 (Annexure P-5) to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No.2 and he shall be satisfied at this stage, if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.
3. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to look into representation dated 08.11.2024 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate action within two weeks, in accordance with law.
