1. Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C is for quashing of DDR/G.D. No. 31 (Annexure P-1) dated 13.06.2023 under Sections 323 and 34 of IPC and Sections 325 and 201, IPC added later on registered at Police Station Sadar Raikot in FIR No.0068 (Annexure P-2) dated 15/06/2023, under Sections 324, 323 and 34 of IPC and sections, 326 and 201 of IPC added later on registered at Police Station Sadar Raikot, District Ludhiana Rural and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

2. This Court vide order dated 17.07.2025 had directed the parties to appear before the Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send



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his/her report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jagraon and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted report dated 28.07.2025 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

6. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant F.I.R. following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052 titled as '*Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another*' and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in (2012) 10 SCC 303 titled as '*Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others*', this petition is allowed and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise qua petitioner(s), are hereby quashed.
