The petitioner has impugned the order dated 09.12.2024 (Annexure P-12), passed by respondent No.5, whereby the path connecting Vijay Nagar and Sector 11 (Extension) has been declared as a public road. The petitioner is further seeking a direction to the respondents to close the illegal passage in Sector 11 (Extension), Jind.

2. Issue notice to the respondents.

3. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Anant Kataria, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 5.

4. Mr. Deepak Sabherwal, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 to 4 and while referring to the reply filed by respondents No.2 to 4, submits that in pursuance to the order dated 24.04.2024 passed by the Division Bench of this Court in CWP No.8566 of 2024, all the concerned parties were afforded an opportunity of personal hearing and an order has been passed by the Deputy Commissioner on 09.12.2024, whereby path between Sector 11 (Extension) and Vijay Nagar has been declared as a public road. It is also mentioned that there was an illegal entry towards a private colony, which has been closed by construction of a wall. Copy of the photograph is Annexure R-2.

5. In view of the reply filed on behalf of respondents No.2 to 4, we are of the considered view that grievance of the petitioner has been substantially redressed. In the event of any subsisting grievance, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek recourse to the alternative remedy in accordance with law and to approach respondent No.4 for redressal of his grievance, if any.

6. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
