Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take action against the private respondents as per law.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has inter alia contended that respondent No.5 and his family members have given colour of crime to a simple accident and had cleverly got registered the FIR against the petitioner's son Harpreet Singh @ Sahil and his friends with false allegations. He has further contended that the petitioner's son received serious injuries and when the petitioner tried to get registered the cross case against Fateh Singh and his family members, then respondent No.4 refused to register the FIR against them, with the remarks that the petitioner's son was a habitual offender, without conducting any inquiry/ investigation of the incident.

Grievance of the petitioner is that the cross version case was not registered as per the allegations levelled by the petitioner, regarding

causing of serious injuries to his son. When the efficacious alternative remedy available to the petitioner, has not been utilized, then the present petition is not maintainable and is disposed of accordingly.
