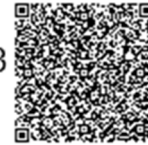


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**IN THE PUNJAB AND HARYANA HIGH COURT AT

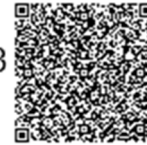

The petitioners have filed the instant petition seeking directions to the respondents to release the salary of the petitioners for the period from July 2024 till date and also for revision of the salary of the petitioners from 01.09.2023 in terms of the letter dated 14.10.2024.

2 It has been averred in the writ petition that the petitioners were appointed as Computer Operators on contract basis in the years 2007-08 in the Land Record Project and since then they are continuously working and discharging their duties. The specific date of joining of the petitioners is 05.04.2007, 10.05.2007 and 12.12.2008 respectively. It is also averred that despite the petitioners working with the respondents, their salary since July

2024 has not been released. It is also averred that the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 10.02.2025 (Annexure P-4) but to no avail, and hence, a prayer is made for directing the respondents to decide the representation and pass a speaking and reasoned order in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3 Taking into consideration the prayer made in the present writ petition as also the facts noticed above, I am of the opinion that issuance of the formal notice may not be necessary in the present case in view of the order which this Court proposes to pass.

4 Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.2-Chairman-cum-Deputy Commissioner, District Information Technology Society, Charkhi Dadri, to decide the representation dated 10.02.2025 (Annexure P-4), submitted by the petitioners and to pass a speaking and reasoned order thereupon in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
