The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to grant protection to the petitioner and his representatives at the hands of private respondents and their representatives.

The learned State counsel submits that the civil dispute is already pending between the parties and both the parties wanted to harvest the crop forcibly and keeping in view the possibility of eminent danger to the breach of peace, proceedings under Section 145 Cr.P.C. were initiated and receiver was appointed. Thereafter, the revision petition filed against the order passed under Section 145 Cr.P.C. was allowed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Kaithal. He further submits that except making bald averments of threatening, no date, time and the manner in which alleged threat has been extended, has been ever disclosed by the petitioner. However, the life and liberty of the petitioner shall be protected in accordance with law, in case, any specific

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material is brought to the notice of the jurisdictional police authorities.

In view of the averments made by the learned State counsel and the specific stand taken in the status report, no further directions are required to be passed in the present petition and the present petition is disposed of accordingly.
