HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the parties submits that the punishment of suspension was imposed upon the petitioners by the authority concerned vide order dated 19.03.2025 (Annexure P-3) for 4 consecutive regular semesters.

2. Keeping in view the punishment of suspension imposed, the petitioners were also restrained from appearing in the examination but as per the order passed by this Court dated 23.04.2025, the petitioners were allowed to appear in the examination subject to filing an undertaking that they will not indulge in any such activity which causes harm to the reputation of the institution or to any of the students studying in the said institution. Further, they were directed to give an undertaking that they will maintain good conduct throughout the academic course till the completion of the same.



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3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the said undertaking has already been given and the petitioners will abide by the same.

4. Keeping in view the fact that the incident occurred spontaneously and the petitioners who are the students have realized their mistake coupled with the fact that other students have already withdrawn their complaint, suspending the petitioners for 4 consecutive regular semesters so as to cause academic harm will not be in the interest of anyone.

5. Hence, keeping in view the undertaking given by the petitioners that they will maintain a good conduct throughout the academic course, the suspension of the petitioners ordered on 19.03.2025 (Annexure P-3) for 4 consecutive regular semester are set aside.

6. However, the institution will be free to initiate proceedings or to take appropriate action in case the petitioners violate the said undertaking in any manner in future.

7. The present writ petition is disposed of in above terms.
