1. Prayer in this petition under Section 482 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.119, dated 18.05.2024 (Annexure P-1), registered at Police Station Civil Line, Rohtak, District Rohtak under Sections 323/34/506 of IPC (Section 307 of IPC added later on).

2. On oral request made by learned counsel for the petitioners, offence under Section 201 of IPC added in the present petition. Registry is directed to do the needful.

3. Today, on instructions from ASI Ram Mehar, learned State counsel has informed this Court that the petitioners have joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 10.07.2025 and are no longer required for further investigation.



4. Ms. Tanya Malik, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and filed her vakalatnama, which is taken on record. Counsel for the complainant has admitted that the dispute has been settled and matter has been compromised between the petitioners and the complainant.

5. In view of the aforesaid, the present petition is disposed of and the order dated 10.07.2025, whereby the petitioners were granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of the BNSS [erstwhile Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.].

6. Pending misc application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
