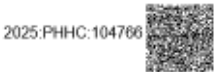
1 Present petition has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 for grant of regular bail in FIR No.254 dated 24.09.2022 under Sections 379-B, 395, 482, 411 and 149 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that out of 10 accused persons, 9 accused person are granted the concession of bail by this Court vide orders annexed with the petition as Annexure P-3 to Annexure P-10.

3. Learned State counsel has not disputed this fact that the case of the present petitioner is on the same footing as that of co-accused who were enlarged on bail.

4. Heard.

5. Without expressing on the merits of the case, and taking into account the custody period of the petitioner coupled with the fact that co-accused have already been granted concession of bail and there is every



likelihood of the trial being not concluded in near future, regular bail petition filed by the petitioner is allowed. He is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
