1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to quash the FIR No.34, dated 28.02.2017, under Sections 279,337,338 of IPC and 304-A of IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Sadar Kurali, District SAS Nagar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising out therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 11.04.2025 (Annexure P-2).

2. During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner has informed the Court that the petitioner has been convicted by the Trial Court and an appeal is pending before the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar. Since, the offence under Section 304-A of IPC is non-compoundable, the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the pleas available to him before the Appellate Court, at an appropriate

stage.

3. Since, the accused have compromised the matter with the legal representatives of the deceased, a lenient view may be taken while awarding the sentence to the petitioner by the Appellate Court.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty aforesaid.
