Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, is for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 4 to arrest all the accused i.e. respondent Nos.5 to 10 and complete the investigation within time bound manner in case FIR No.92 dated 28.07.2024, under Sections 304(2), 116(2), 117(2), 320(2), 101 (3), 100/361(2) of BNSS, 2023, registered at Police Station City Patti, Tehsil Patti, District Tarn Taran, Punjab, along with further prayer to direct the respondent Nos.1 and 4 to recover licensed pistol of the petitioner from the illegal possession of respondent Nos.5 to 10.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the pending representation (Annexure P-6) is decided by respondent No.2.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Inder Jeet Singh Ladher, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice and submitted that he has not objection if the aforesaid representation dated 19.04.2025 (Annexure P-6) is decided.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2—Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, to look into the representation dated 15.04.2025 (Annexure P6) and to take appropriate action, if any required, at the earliest.
