



accused in three other cases of similar nature wherein he was acquitted. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in one other criminal case of similar nature petitioner is enlarged on anticipatory bail and that petitioner is ready to join the investigation with the police.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Neeraj Sheoran, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Haryana and on instructions from Head Constable Ashok Kumar, submits that petitioner who is named in the FIR is required by the police for proper investigation in this case, as at the time of police raid, petitioner succeeded in escaping from there but police recovered fresh beef and two feeble cows and motor cycle and some sharp articles etc. from the spot.

Learned State counsel prays for time to seek instructions regarding fresh criminal status of the petitioner.

In the light of the fact that recovery is already effected in the present case, the petitioner is hereby directed to join the investigation with the police and in case of arrest, he is to be released on interim bail by the investigating officer/arresting officer to his own satisfaction till the next date fixed in this case. The petitioner is also to abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C.

Now be listed on 14.08.2024.”

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar, submits that in compliance of order dated 14.05.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

4. Keeping in view the statement made by learned State Counsel, the order dated 14.05.2024, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

5. The petition is accordingly disposed of.

6. Nothing observed hereinabove shall be construed to be an



expression of opinion by this Court lest it may prejudice the trial. The learned trial Court is directed to proceed with the trial on its own merits, strictly in accordance with law.
