By way of the present writ petition, the petitioner has sought issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent Nos.2 to 4 to take an appropriate decision on the representation/application dated 17.02.2025 (Annexure P-9) submitted by the petitioner and to allot a residential plot to the petitioner under the 'Oustees Policy' keeping in view the judgment dated 24.10.2013 (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite making the aforesaid representation to the competent authority-respondent No.4, no action has been taken thereon till date. He further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the respondent authorities are directed to deal with

his concerns/grievances and pass appropriate order on the said representation.

3. Served with the advance copy of the petition, Mr. Gaurav Bansal, DAG, Haryana and Mr. Karan Jindal, AAG, Haryana, appear on behalf of the respondent-State and Mr. Ankur Mittal, Advocate, along with Ms. Ashna Singh, Advocate, Ms. Sharvi Dadhwal, Advocate and Ms. Saanvi Singla, Advocate, appears on behalf of respondent Nos. 2 to 4-HSVP. Learned counsel for respondent Nos. 2 to 4-HSVP submits that the said representation/application shall be considered and decided by the competent authority, in accordance with law.

4. Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Estate Officer, HSVP (competent authority) to look into the pending representation dated 17.02.2025 (Annexures P-9) and pass an appropriate reasoned order thereon, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy/production of this order.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
