1. In the present writ petition, the petitioners are praying for quashing of orders dated 21.03.2024 (Annexure P-3) and 30.04.2024 (Annexure P-4) whereby, a fact finding enquiry for ascertaining the role of the petitioner has been ordered.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the issue involved in the present writ petition is duly covered by the judgment passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in case titled as **Punjab State Warehousing Corporation Field Employees Union versus Union of India and others**, CWP No.27725 of 2013 and other connected petitions, decided



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on 14.05.2025. However, he submits that a perusal of the aforesaid order would reflect that the liberty has been granted to the petitioners therein, to submit the representation, which will be considered by the concerned authority in terms of the order passed by the Court. He further submits that the present petition may be treated as a representation and the respondent be directed to consider the same in light of the order passed in CWP No.27725 of 2013 and other connected petitions, decided on 14.05.2025.

4. The respondent is directed to treat the present writ petition as a representation and take a decision in terms of the judgment passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-27725 of 2013 and other connected petitions, decided on 14.05.2025
