Prayer in the instant writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside the letter/notice dated 20.10.2020 (Annexure P-2) issued by respondent No.2-Regional Passport Office, Chandigarh, whereby the passport of the petitioner has been revoked.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the letter/notice dated 20.10.2020 (Annexure P-2) is appealable before learned Chief Passport Officer and he may be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file an appeal impugning the aforesaid letter/notice dated 20.10.2020 (Annexure P-2), in accordance with law.
