Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed praying for quashing of FIR No.0031 dated 27.01.2016, under Sections 406, 420, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Butana, District Karnal along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Reply by way of affidavit dated 28.03.2018 of Sh. Dalbir Singh, HPS, DSP, Assandh, Karnal on behalf of respondent No.1, filed in the Registry, is ordered to be taken on record. Registry to tag the same at the appropriate place.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Harbhajan Singh, has stated that after investigation of the aforesaid FIR by Special Investigation Team (SIT), both the petitioners were found innocent and their names were kept in Column No.2 in supplementary report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. and the same has been submitted against one Parkash Mishra.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.

Needless to say that further necessary action shall be taken expeditiously by learned trial Court in the matter.
