MANISHA BATRA, J.(ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking quashing of impugned order dated 09.04.2025 (Annexure P-6) passed by Judge Special Court, Hoshiarpur, whereby, the bail of the petitioner was cancelled and her bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited to the State.

It is, *inter alia*, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had been regularly appearing before the learned trial Court. On 09.04.2025, the petitioner could not appear before the concerned Court as due to inadvertence she had noted next date of hearing as 29.04.2025 instead of 09.04.2025. He further submits that the absence of the petitioner was not intentional. The petitioner is ready to join the proceedings before the learned trial Court and to abide by the terms and conditions to be imposed upon her.

On perusal of order dated 09.04.2025, it is revealed that the bail of the petitioner was cancelled due to her non-appearance. Though, no ground whatsoever has been made out for holding that there is any illegality

and infirmity in the impugned order, however, in view of the fact that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings before the learned trial Court and has filed the present petition at the very outset, the same is disposed of by giving directions to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court within a period of 15 days from today. On her doing so and on furnishing of fresh bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court, she shall be admitted to bail by the learned trial Court.

Disposed of in above terms.
