1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 BNSS, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.261 dated 16.11.2024 under Sections 420/406/120-B of IPC registered at Police Station Samrala, District Ludhiana (wrongly mentioned as 'Khanna' in the head-note) (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia*, contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case as the petitioner was married with co-accused-Kirandeep Kaur and both of them are residing separately since long. He further contends that FIR (*supra*), clearly indicates that the petitioner had not received a single penny from respondent No.2 and the allegations in the FIR (*supra*) are levelled against co-accused-Kirandeep Kaur only. Further, the petitioner has no concern or connection with the alleged money and the FIR (*supra*) has been registered only to harass the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case all the documents, which are annexed with the present



petition and all the averments made herein, are considered by the Investigating Officer before submitting the final report under Section 193 of BNSS, 2023 (*erstwhile Section 173 Cr.P.C.*).

3. Notice of motion.
4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and submits that he has no objection, in case the Investigating Officer is directed to consider all the documents, which are annexed with the present petition, before preparing the final report under Section 193 of BNSS, 2023 (*erstwhile Section 173 Cr.P.C.*).
5. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and after perusing the record of the case with their able assistance and with the consent of parties, the matter is taken up for final disposal today itself.
6. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Investigating Officer to consider all the documents, which are annexed with the present petition and averments made in the present petition before preparing the final report under Section 193 of BNSS, 2023 (*erstwhile Section 173 Cr.P.C.*).
7. It is clarified that in case, final report under Section 193 of BNSS, 2023 (*erstwhile Section 173 Cr.P.C.*) is against the petitioner, he would be at liberty to file a fresh petition to challenge the FIR (*supra*) as well as the final report under Section 193 of BNSS, 2023 (*erstwhile Section 173 Cr.P.C.*).
