1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus/prohibition for directing respondent No. 1-learned Financial Commissioner (Revenue), Haryana to consider and decide the revision petition (ROR-134-2025) titled as ***Rai Singh and others Versus District Revenue Officer***, submitted by the petitioner, in a time bound manner and further staying the dispossession of the petitioner.

2. In pursuance of advance copy of petition having been served upon respondent-State, Ms. Upasana Dhawan, AAG Haryana appears on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. She, on instructions from Mr. Tek Chand, Reader, O/o Financial Commissioner (Revenue), Haryana, submits that the revision petition (ROR-134-2025), filed by the petitioner, is presently listed for 26.05.2025 and in all probability, the prayer for grant of stay in the said revision petition would be considered and decided by the

said officer on the date fixed i.e. 26.05.2025 and in any case, not beyond two weeks thereafter. She further submits that the warrants of possession already stand issued against the petitioner for 25.04.2025, would be deferred till the decision of the said application.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid stand taken by learned State counsel, the instant civil writ petition stands disposed of.

4. Pending application (s), if any, shall also stand closed.
