On 01.12.2022, following order was passed:-

“Atul Soni, DSP, Jalalabad, District Fazilka has appeared in person. Even the affidavit of SSP Fazilka filed on behalf of respondent No.1-State in compliance of the previous order dated 07.09.2022, which is ordered to be taken on record.

The State counsel apprised this Court that raids are being conducted to apprehend Dharminder who has jumped parole and proceedings have already been initiated against his sureties.

In the light of the above, now be listed on 23.02.2023 and the presence of DSP is discharged.

The State counsel is directed to furnish the fresh status report with regard to arrest of aforesaid Dharminder @ Kala on the next date of hearing.

Photocopy of the order be also placed in the connected matter.”

Today learned State counsel has placed on record affidavit of Shri Rajdeep Singh, Additional Superintendent, Central Jail, Ferozepur in connected petition bearing No.CRWP-824-2021 (O&M), as per which petitioner has

surrendered himself in jail on 27.03.2023 as per the order of this Court in CWP No.6233 of 2023 and presently he is confined in jail. However, nobody is representing the petitioner. Even on the last date of hearing i.e. on 01.12.2022, as reproduced above nobody had made appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

It appears that petitioner is no longer interested in pursuing the petition.

Dismissed in default for want of prosecution.
