1. In the present petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.1 not to effect recovery from the pension of the petitioner till the pendency of the statutory appeal dated 14.01.2025 (Annexure P-2) filed by him against the punishment order dated 16.12.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.1 whereby, the recovery of Rs.5,76,110/- has been imposed upon the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, prays that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to decide the appeal filed by the petitioner expeditiously by passing a speaking order.
3. Notice of motion.



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4. Ms. Shivani Sharma, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has no objection to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner

5. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Appellate Authority to consider and decide the appeal dated 14.01.2025 (Annexure P-2), within a period of 06 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

6. Since the statutory appeal is still pending and yet to be decided, it will be in the interest of justice that no further recovery be effected from the pension of the petitioner till the disposal of the appeal.
