1. The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioner(s) seeking issuance of an appropriate writ especially in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant the minimum pay-scale as per regular selected employees from the date of their appointment.

2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that as regards their grievances mentioned in the petition, the petitioner(s) have already sent a demand notice dated 15.02.2025 (Annexure P-9) to the respondent(s) and they would be satisfied in case respondent No.2, is directed to consider and decide the said demand notice by passing a well reasoned and speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State and submits that she has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

With the consent of the parties, the present petition is accordingly **disposed of** without commenting on the merits of the present case and with a direction to respondent No.2-Director, Health Services, Haryana to take note of the demand notice dated 15.02.2025 (Annexure P-9) sent by the petitioner and to pass a well reasoned and speaking order thereupon after granting an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties in accordance with law and preferably within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
