1. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the present writ petition was admitted as State of Punjab had also challenged the same Award in CWP No.7483 of 1999 titled as State of Punjab and others vs. Mr. Abdul Mishar and another.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that the issue had already been settled between the parties before the Lok Adalat which is clear from the order dated 20.12.2016 passed by the Lok Adalat in CWP No.7483 of 1999 wherein, all the disputes with the workman had already been settled with the family as the workman had unfortunately died hence, keeping in view the settlement between the family of the petitioner, the present petition does not survive.

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3. As the petitioner has already died and nobody has come forward to pursue the present petition and further in the order passed by the Lok Adalat in CWP No.7483 of 1999, there is a specific mention of settlement between the parties hence, the present writ petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous. However, liberty is given to revive the same in case any of the dispute still survives.
