Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents, along with further prayer to direct the official respondents to take action on representation dated 21.04.2024 (Annexure P-7) moved by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that there is threat perception to the petitioner at the hands of private respondent No.4, who has been excluded in the will executed by the deceased husband of the petitioner. He has contended that petitioner is being threatened and harassed on behest of the private respondents who bore grudge and had an intention to eliminate the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner filed representation dated 21.04.2024 (Annexure P-7) before Director General of Police, Punjab, but till date no action has been taken.

During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner stated that he would be satisfied, in case, the pending representation (Annexure P-7) is decided by respondent No.1.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Gagandeep Kaur, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice and submitted that she has no objection if the aforesaid representation dated 21.04.2024 (Annexure P-7) is decided.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1, to look into the representation (Annexure P7) and to take appropriate action, if any required, at the earliest.
