

of law in the context of common set of facts and thus they are being decided by a common order.

2. In terms of the last order, an affidavit dated 20.01.2025 of respondent No.6 Mr. Dusmanta Kumar Behera, IAS, Director General and Secretary, Development and Panchayats Department, Haryana has been filed wherein, it has been mentioned that all the glitches to assess the website has been rectified and now anyone can assess the said website. As per the affidavit, the website is in Hindi (Devnagri).

3. Keeping in view the said affidavit and the facts mentioned therein, which have been rebutted in any manner to be incorrect, the same is accepted and no further order is required to be passed keeping in view the facts stated hereinbefore.

4. With regard to the claim of the petitioner(s) qua the supply of the information, it has already been noticed that in the previous order that all the information sought for has already been supplied to the petitioner(s), which has been noticed in the order dated 13.11.2024 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench that all the information has been received. Hence, no further order is required to be passed in the present petition and the present set of petitions are disposed of as such.

5. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
