By way of the present writ petition, the petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to hand over the physical possession of commercial building and to consider representation dated 28.02.2025 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that aggrieved from the inaction of the respondents, the petitioner has already filed a representation dated 28.02.2025 (Annexure P-6) upon the respondents, but

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no action has been taken thereon till date. He further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the respondent authorities are directed to deal with their concerns/grievances and pass appropriate order on the said representation.

3. Served with the advance copy of the petition, Mr. Gaurav Bansal, DAG, Haryana, for respondent No.1 and Mr. Ankur Mittal, Advocate for respondent No.2, are present in Court and submit that the said representation shall be considered and looked into by the competent authority, in accordance with law.

4. Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 (competent authority), to look into the representation dated 28.02.2025 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioner and take an appropriate action thereon, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy/production of this order.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
