By way of the present writ petition, the petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of prohibition directing the respondent-authorities not to take any action against the petitioner pursuant to the notice dated 25.03.2025 (Anneuxre P-7).

2. A perusal of the averments made in the writ petition would show that as of now, only a notice has been issued by respondent No.2 for removal of the illegal encroachment by the petitioner on the land in question.

3. We are of the opinion that the petitioner is at liberty to file reply to the said notice before the respondent-authorities. It is made clear that in case any adverse order is passed against the petitioner, he would be at liberty to challenge the said order, in accordance with law. Ordered accordingly.

4. The present writ petition is disposed of in the above terms.
