1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the '*Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita*', 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.102, dated 11.04.2025, under Sections 115 (2), 117 (2), 118 (2), 191 (3) and 190 of the '*Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita*, 2023, registered at Police Station Kharar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.
2. The petitioner was directed to join the investigation, as per the order dated 28.04.2025 passed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court.
3. Learned counsel for the State, on instructions, confirms that the petitioner has joined investigation and also contends that his further custodial interrogation is not required.
4. In view of the reasons recorded in the order dated 28.04.2025 and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, his further custodial interrogation is not required by the Investigating Agency,



the present petition is allowed and the order dated 28.04.2025, granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. However, it is made clear that nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of opinion on merits of the case.

6. Liberty is reserved in favour of the State/complainant to move for cancellation/recall of the order in case the petitioner violates any condition stipulated under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C., or upon showing any other sufficient cause.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
