- 1. Petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.17 dated 10.03.2025 under Sections 7-A of the P.C. Act and Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Patiala Range, Patiala.
- 2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 08.05.2025 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
- 3. A short reply by way of an affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Vigilance Bureau Unit Sangrur has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State and the same is taken on record.
- 4. Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
- 4. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 08.05.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S.
