Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that though, the petitioner has retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 31.1.2023 but his retiral benefits have not been released to him by the respondents on the ground of pendency of disciplinary proceedings against the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as of 08.07.2024, the petitioner has already been exonerated of the allegations alleged against him but his pensionary benefits have not been released so far hence, the respondents may kindly be directed to release the pensionary benefits admissible to the petitioner forthwith.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance

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which has been raised in the present petition, has already been raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 05.12.2024 (Annexure P/6), which is pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case, a direction is issued to respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. T.P.S. Chawla, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice of behalf of respondents and submits that in case, representation dated 05.12.2024 (Annexure P/6) has been received from the petitioner, the same will be decided by the respondents by passing appropriate speaking order within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which order will be conveyed to the petitioner for her information and necessary action.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
