1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 in case FIR No.62 dated 02.04.2025, registered under Sections 109, 324 (4), 351(2) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in compliance of order dated 14.05.2025 passed by this Court and he has also produced the vehicle as well as licensed weapon before the police.

3. Learned counsel for the State, upon instructions, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of order dated 14.05.2025 passed by this Court and his custodial interrogation is not required for further investigation.



4. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 14.05.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
