AMARJOT BHATTI, J. (Oral)

1. Learned proxy counsel representing petitioner requested for an adjournment. Even on the earlier date, regular counsel did not appear and presence of proxy counsel was marked.
2. Status report already received. I have considered the petition as well as status report filed in this case.

Petitioner Rajpal Kaur filed petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondent No. 4 on her representation (Annexure P-2). As per status report, matter was inquired by Inspector Parvinder Singh, SHO of Police Station Kotwali Bathinda. Statement of petitioner Rajpal Kaur was recorded who conceded her relationship with Deep Singh @ Deepu for last about 10 years. They started residing together at Amritsar. They lived there for about two years and then shifted to Bathinda in the year 2024. Due to domestic dispute,

Deep Singh @ Deepu deserted her. She was three months pregnant. Now, matter has been reconciled. She has given birth to a girl child on 11.06.2025 and they have started living together peacefully. It was further confirmed that there was no complaint against each other and wanted to withdraw present case.

3. In the light of status report referred above, no further action is required. Parties have reconciled. Therefore, present petition stands disposed of having rendered infructuous.

4. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stands disposed of accordingly.
