1. The prayer made in the present petition is for directing the respondents to regularise the service of the petitioners as they are continuously working since 2012 and their juniors have also been regularised.

Learned counsel submits that regarding the claim as raised in the present petition, a legal notice dated 25.12.2024, Annexure P-6, has been served upon respondents, however, the same has yet not evoked any response. He thus, on instructions prays that a direction may be given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner, to which learned State counsel has no objection to the limited prayer made.

case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 25.12.2024, expeditiously, in accordance with law.
