Ltd. Versus M/s Bird Machines Pvt. Ltd. and others**”, as well as summoning order dated 20.03.2024 (P-2), passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Faridabad, whereby petitioners have been summoned to face trial for the offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

(2) In view of the order, passed in the aforesaid application (CRM-16347-2025), present petition is disposed off as withdrawn.
