FAO-2386-2005**SAT NARAIN VS. SUKHBIR AND ORS.**

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Mr. Vivek Dahiya, Advocate has filed power of attorney on behalf of the appellant along with copy of Aadhar Card & disability certificate of the appellant, which are taken on record.

Discussed.

A statement made on behalf of the appellant that in full and final satisfaction of his claim, an amount of Rs.8,50,000/- (Rupees Eight Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the tribunal be awarded and be disbursed to the appellant-Sat Narain son of Chandan, having been accepted on behalf of the insurer of the offending vehicle, the appeal is disposed of with a direction to the insurer to deposit with the office of the Lok Adalat a cheque in the sum of Rs.8,50,000/- (Rupees Eight Lakh Fifty Thousand Only), favouring the appellant-Sat Narain son of Chandan, within six weeks from today, failing which the amount hereby awarded shall carry interest @ 9% per annum from the date of this order till payment thereof. Learned counsel for the appellant has stated that amount awarded by learned Tribunal has already been received by the appellant.

The cheque so deposited may be collected by the appellant or the counsel representing the appellant against proper receipt.

Miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of.

A copy of this order be made available to each of the appearing counsel, and file be consigned.
