JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to the respondents to release his retiral dues.

2. The petitioner claims that respondent till date has only released his leave encashment whereas he is entitled to GPF, GIS, gratuity, commutation and pension. He retired on 30.09.2024 on attaining the age of superannuation.

3. Ms. Rajni Gupta, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who on advance notice is present in Court on behalf of the respondents, submits that petitioner has not removed deficiencies pointed out by authorities, thus, there is delay in releasing his retiral dues.

4. Be that as it may, this Court deems it appropriate to direct respondent to point out specific deficiencies in one go to the petitioner



within 15 days from today and thereafter, release benefits within four weeks from the date of removal of deficiencies.

5. Disposed of in above terms.
