1. Present petition has been filed seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 8.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted the private respondents are hell-bent in taking unlawful possession of the land belonging to the petitioners and have been repeatedly threatening them in this regard.

3. At this Stage, Ms. Seena Sandhu, Addl. A.G.Punjab, submits that she has received advance copy of the petition and has also sought instructions in the present case to state that after the complaint was received from the petitioner to the police, preventive action have been



taken and proceedings under Sections 107/151 of Cr.P.C. or Sections 126 and 170 of BNSS, 2023 have been initiated.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that, in view of the statement made by the learned State counsel for the respondents, he does not wish to press the present petition and the same may be disposed of. However, it is prayed that liberty be granted to the petitioners to approach the concerned police station or the Senior Superintendent of Police (SSP), in case any imminent threat to their life and liberty arises in future and in case any appropriate application is moved then the same may be considered forthwith for protection of their life and liberty.

5. Learned State counsel stated that she has no objection in case the aforesaid liberty is granted to the petitioners to move further application in case it is so required in the present case.

6. In view of the aforesaid statements made by both the learned counsels for the parties, present petition is disposed of.
