1. Prayer made in the present petition is for directing the respondents to grant conveyance allowance to the petitioners from the date of joining of services and reliance is placed on the judgment of this Court in **Reema Singal vs. State of Punjab and others**, CWP-11926-2019, decided on 29.11.2024, regarding which a legal notice dated 10.03.2025, Annexure P-14, has been served upon the respondents, which has yet not evoked any response. Learned counsel, on instructions, prays that a direction may be given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner, to which learned State counsel has no objection.

2. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 10.03.2025, within a

period of 4 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to them and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to their interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioners shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
