1. Prayer in the present petition filed under 528 of BNSS, 2023 seeking directions to official respondents to release the daughter of the petitioner from Deepalaya Children's Home (DCH) situated at village Gusbethi, Sahsola Patti, Block Taoru, Haryana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that minor daughter of the petitioner was induced by a boy, namely, Rihan. Further, on the basis of her statement recorded before the Magistrate, she was sent to institute of respondent No.4 for residing. Learned counsel further submits that on 22.12.2024, when the petitioner and his family members went to meet their daughter at Deepalya Children's Home, the minor girl wanted to go back with them. In this regard, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 22.04.2025 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.4, but no action was taken.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.4 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-1) submitted by the



petitioner, in a time bound manner.

- 4. Notice of motion to official respondents only.
- 5. Ms. Geeta Sharma, DAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply a copy of complete paper book to learned State counsel today itself.
- 6. Mr. Neeraj Kumar, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of private respondent Arjun and filed his *vakalatnama* which is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at the appropriate place.
- 7. Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate steps in view of the submissions made therein, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
