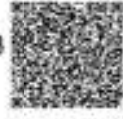

1. By way of the present writ petition, the petitioner has sought issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside election of respondent No.5 under Section 13C of Haryana Municipal Act, 1973 on the ground of



giving wrong affidavit with regard to the description of the property.

2. Served with the advance copy of the petition, Mr. Ankur Mittal, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and submits that the petitioner has already made complaint dated 18.02.2025 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.4, but no action has been taken thereon till date. He further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the respondent authorities are directed to deal with the concerns/grievances and pass an appropriate order on the said complaint.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4, submits that the said complaint shall be considered and decided by the respondent authority, in accordance with law.

4. Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4, to look into the pending complaint dated 18.02.2025 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner and pass an appropriate reasoned order thereon, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy/production of this order.
