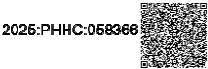

The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondent/Department to release the third ACP grades to the petitioner in terms of the Haryana Civil Service ACP Rules, 2016, with effect from 01.12.2024.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case second respondent is directed to decide the pending representation, dated 05.02.2025, Annexure P-3, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and submits that the pending representation, dated 05.02.2025, will be decided by the second respondent/Director, Elementary Education, by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of three months.



5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
6. Ordered accordingly.
7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
