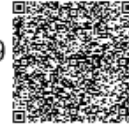

**MANISHA BATRA, J. (Oral)**

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of an appropriate order or direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 to 7 and take action on her representation dated 22.04.2025 (Annexure P-2).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has recently filed a representation on 22.04.2025 before the Superintendent of Police, District Sonapat, Haryana (Annexure P-2) raising her grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2-



Superintendent of Police, District Sonapat, Haryana to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Apoorv Garg, Sr. DAG, Haryana who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforesaid representation dated 22.04.2025 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner within a period of 15 days from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
