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SHEEL NAGU, C.J. (Oral)

1. In the present petition, the grievance is non-provision of 3% reservation to physically handicapped in public employment in the State of Haryana.
2. The State of Haryana vide Notification dated 25.03.2022 has extended the benefit of reservation in promotion to persons with benchmark disability including the members of the petitioner-Association.
3. This fact is evident from the Award passed by the Supreme Court Special Lok Adalat dated 31.07.2024, which for ready reference and convenience is reproduced as under:-

“Learned counsel for the appellants submits that in view of the judgment of the three-Judge Bench of this Court dated 14.01.2020 in Civil Appeal No.1567 of 2017, the Government of Haryana, General Administration Department, has issued a



notification dated 25.03.2022 extending benefit of reservation in promotion to the persons with benchmark disabilities including the members of the respondent's Association. In view of the above, it is urged that this appeal has now rendered infructuous.

Accordingly, by the consent of the parties, this appeal stands disposed of as infructuous.

Court fee be refunded as per rules."

4. In view of the above, the cause raised herein has become infructuous.

5. Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
