IOIN-1-CWP-21275-2008 has been put up by the Registry, as the Mediator of Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court has made a request for extension of time.

On 30.10.2025, the following order was passed by this Court:-

"Office note perused.

A perusal of the report from the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court, would show that a request has been made by the Mediator for extension of time.

Learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 submits that the relief claimed in the writ petition has already been granted to the petitioner, and as such, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.



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Notice to learned counsel for the petitioner as well as petitioner be issued for 17.11.2025.”

A perusal of the case file would show that on the last three dates of hearing i.e. 20.05.2025, 22.07.2025 & 30.10.2025, none had caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Today also, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.2 & 3 submits that nothing survives in the present writ petition and the same may be disposed of, as relief claimed by the petitioner in the instant petition has already been granted to the petitioner.

In view of the submission made by learned counsel for respondents No.2 & 3, the main case is taken on board today itself.

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Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner which clearly shows that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the case.

In view of above, the instant petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to file an application for revival of the petition, if any cause survives.

As such, the order has been passed in the main case, IOIN-1-CWP-21275-2008 also stands disposed of.
