The prayer in the present Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus to release the minor detenue Babli D/o Rajinder Kumar who is under detention of the private respondents.

A status report dated 29.05.2025 by way of an affidavit of ASI Mukesh 1479/C, P.S. Mauli Jagri, U.T., Chandigarh has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He states that as per the reply, the alleged detenue was examined under Section 183 BNSS, 2023 (Section 164 Cr.P.C.) wherein she stated that she did not want a medical check up and had not been subjected to sexual intercourse. She further stated that she had gone with her friend to Himachal Pradesh.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
