1. Through the instant writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a challenge is thrown to an Award dated 13.05.2023 (Annexure P-1), passed by the Lok Adalat, wherethrough, on the basis of a compromise effected between the parties concerned therein, an amount of Rs.6,25,000/- was awarded in favour of the present petitioners/claimants.

2. The Award (*supra*), has been challenged on the ground of an inadequate compensation. However, no cogent argument has been raised by learned counsel for the petitioners before this Court to the effect that the Award was passed without the consent of the present petitioners.

3. Since the Award (*supra*), has been passed by the Lok Adalat concerned, with the consent of the present petitioners, this Court of the

considered view that, now they cannot challenge the same on the ground inadequacy of compensation. Therefore, the instant petition is ordered to be **dismissed**.
