“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was not initially named in the FIR and has been falsely involved later on. He further contends that the allotment of two SCOs i.e. SCOs No.30 & 08 in Sectors 23/23A, Gurugram was made by the officials of the HSVP. On parity, the file regarding allotment of SCO No.13 in favour of Amit, GPA holder of R.R. Construction Pvt. Ltd. was also prepared and the petitioner had prepared her report as per the settled norms. He further contends that later on, the

allotment of the said SCO in favour of Amit, GPA holder of R.R. Construction Pvt. Ltd., was cancelled and no financial loss was caused to the HSVP. As per the learned counsel, the case is based on documentary evidence and the same has already been collected by the police during the course of investigation. He further contends that the petitioner is ready to join the investigation.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has reiterated the submissions and further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and her custodial interrogation may not be required.

4. On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Prakash Chand submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for the purpose of investigation. He further contends that now warrants of arrest have been issued against Mukesh Kumar Solanki, the main accused and the police is making every endeavour to arrest him. He further contends that even request has been sent by Commissioner of Police, Gurugram to Immigration Bureau for issuance of LOC against Mukesh Kumar Solanki.

5. In view of the above statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 13.05.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
