This common order shall dispose off the present seven

20.09.2023 / 16.01.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Writ Court.

[2] Learned counsel for the respondents points out that the Hon’ble Division Bench has allowed the contempt appeal bearing CACP-47-2024, titled “*Ajoy Kumar Sinha, IAS, Principal Secretary, Department of Finance, Punjab Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh Versus Balwant Singh and others*”, preferred by the respondents against the order dated 20.09.2023 of the Writ Court; thus, no cause survives in the present set of contempt petitions.

[3] In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present contempt petitions, the same are **disposed off** accordingly.
