This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ especially in the nature of Mandamus directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners endangered at the hands of private respondent.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to decide the representation dated 22.04.2025 (Annexure P-4) within a time bound manner.

3. Learned State Counsel assures the Court that the representation will be decided by passing a speaking order within a period of three days from today in the light of notification No.HOME-HM-40 40SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch), after providing opportunity of hearing to the parties.

4. In light of the above, counsel for the petitioner does not wish to press the instant petition.

5. Hence, the instant petition is dismissed as not pressed.
