1. Prayer in the present petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for the issuance of directions to the respondents to ensure safety and security of the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is presently confined in Tihar Jail, New Delhi and prays for his protection while bringing/lodging in Punjab. However, the fact remains that the petitioner has not been brought in Punjab so far and if the petitioner wishes to seek protection during his transit, if any, then the remedy for him is to approach the appropriate Court at Delhi as the present petition is not maintainable before this Court at this stage.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is hereby dismissed being pre mature.
